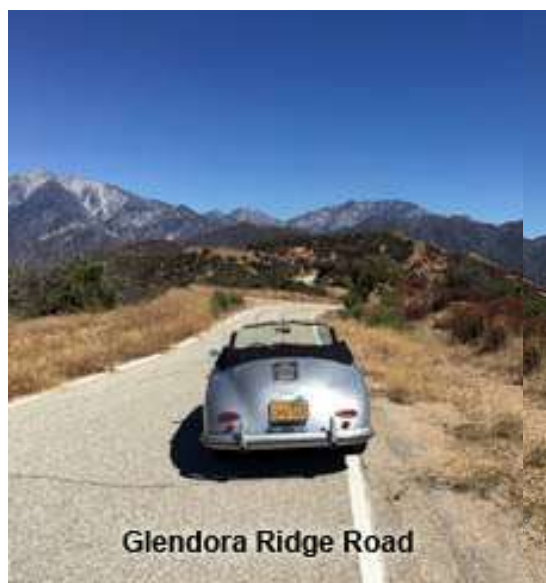

### Going Home

You can reverse the route and take Glendora Ridge Road back to Glendora Mountain Road (GMR): Right on GMR will send you back through San Gabriel Canyon to Azusa (the way we came)—left on GMR will send you to Glendora.

### The Fast Way Home

1. Drive down Mt Baldy Road for 7.8 miles
2. At the traffic light, turn left onto Padua Road
3. Take Padua Road 1.8 miles to Base Line Road/W. 16<sup>th</sup> Street,
4. At the traffic light, turn left onto Base Line Road/W. 16<sup>th</sup> Street then,
  - a. Turn left for the ramp to the 210 westbound or
  - b. Turn right for the ramp to the 210 eastbound.
